Jan. 6, 1827, Fla., d. Sept. 17, 1912. Robert is said to have left home while young and probably lived with kinsmen in Talbot Co. where he met Martha. Robert moved to Cherokee Co., Ala., just before the 1850 census; three of the children were born in Ga. There he lived on his brother, Henry's farm. Robert did not fight in the Civil War. His son died in the service due to complications following a case of measles.

In Dec. 1871, Robert moved to DeSoto Parish, La., leaving behind two married daughters. They traveled by train to Vicksburg, Miss., at which point they took a boat down the Mississippi River and up the Red River to Shreveport, finally arriving by wagon at his brother-in-law's home 4 miles west of Mansfield late Christmas Eve day. He rented land at first but soon patented a small acreage in Ward 3. Cook postoffice was established in his neighborhood but was later abandoned when Rural Free Delivery began. Robert and Martha raised two grand children, Monroe and Andrew Lively. Robert and Martha went back to Ala. to live for a short period, but returned to La. where they died and are buried at Ebenezer Cemetery about 6 miles S. W. of Mansfield. Robert was a Methodist, Martha a Primitive Baptist.

Robert's two "Oath of Amnesty" records, dated Aug. 14, 1865, and Oct. 6, 1865, are family keepsakes. One states that he had fair complexion, dark hair and dark eyes, and was 6 feet high. He wore chin whickers but no mustache. His Bible is in possession of Mrs. T. Ed. Green, 506 Rosamond St., Houston, Texas. Martha was a small woman with strong religious convictions, a believer in predestination. In one of her letters she wrote, "Jesus told Peter to feed my sheep, not to make sheep." She was a lover of poetry. In one of her books on the fly leaf, we find in her handwriting.

"Teach me to feel another's woes  
To hide the faults I see,  
That mercy I to others show  
That mercy show to me.

- Martha L. Anthony"
